Camp Mt. Run, home of Ah'Tic Lodge of Bucktail Council, located approximately twelve miles northeast of DuBois, Pennsylvania, amidst the Pennsylvania State Forest will act as host Lodge for the 1950 Area Fellowship Week-End. The camp is located on both State Forest and Council Property. Being located near Pennsylvania State Forest, Camp Mt. Run is densely wooded and will be appealing to all Arrow men who can attend this Fellowship Encampment.

Members will be lodged in tents and shelters. It will be impossible to furnish each individual with a cot therefore those having folding cots should bring them with them. Each member is asked to furnish his own tick and ground cloth. Sleeping bag, blankets and other bedding are items to be furnished individually.

A first aid cabin will be available to handle first aid needs.

Meals will be furnished in cafeteria style, utensils being furnished by Camp Mt. Run. They promise to be the very best meals and ample portions will be served to all members attending the meeting. The first regular serving will be at Supper on Friday evening. However,

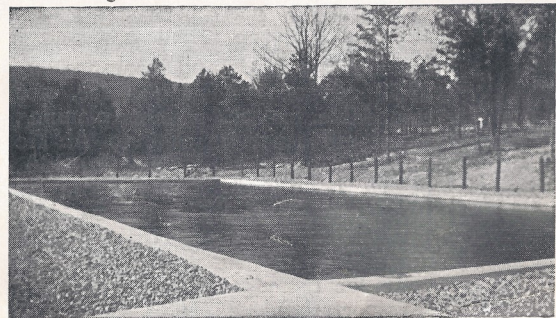
plans call for a light snack on Friday night. Meals will not be served prior to Friday evening. A canteen will be in operation which will provide in-between snacks.

Each Arrow man will be required to furnish his own personal items. The Scout Uniform will be worn on all dress occasions and Arrow Sashes will be the official emblem of recognition. A headband with your Lodge name containing a feather for each Honor will be the distinguishing mark of your Lodge, however your Totem will be another means of identification.

Swapping of neckerchiefs, slides, Totems, etc., will be a feature of this meeting as it always has in the past. Plan to bring whatever you have and join in the fun.

A program has been scheduled covering activities for each day and a printed copy will be given to each one registering for the Meeting. The program has been designed to offer the most in inter-Lodge rituals, recreation and good fellowship.
