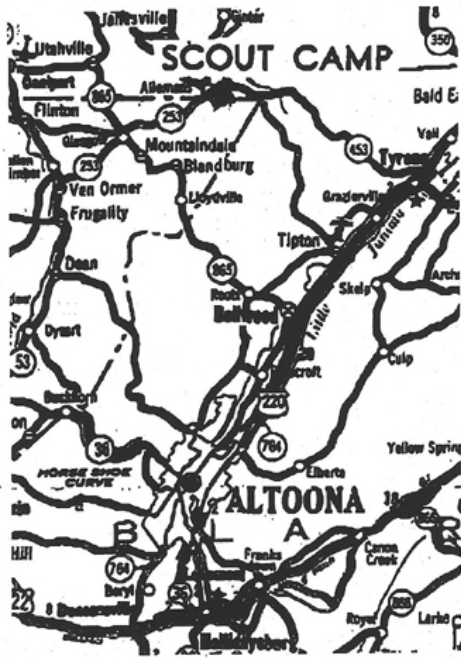

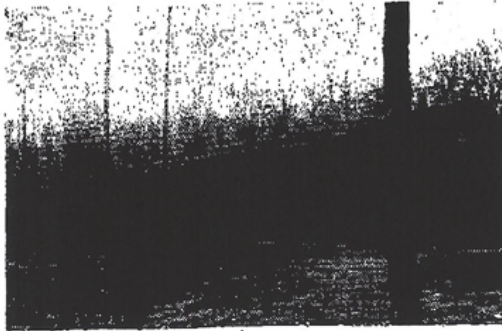

"Located on 590 acres of woodland in southeastern Clearfield County, the Blair-Bedford Scout Reservation is within 25 miles of central Altoona. Both winter and summer camping facilities may be found at the camp. Among its most excellent features is a modern dining hall, which will seat over 300 comfortably, and a large swimming pool. Currently, plans are underway for the construction of a trading post, health lodge, and development of a lake area.

#### HOUSING & SLEEPING ARRANGEMENTS

Sleeping — A tent with platform or two cots each will be provided for each lodge. Each lodge will be housed in separate camp sites (Additional registration above the quota will have to provide their own tent and cots.) Everyone bring your own bedding.

#### EATING

Eating — You'll enjoy every meal in our modern Dining Hall. Five meals will be provided starting with breakfast Saturday and ending with lunch on Sunday plus a snack on Friday and Saturday night.

#### SWIMMING

Swimming — A pool is available for swimming. Life guards will be provided. A medical slip is a must if you expect to go swimming.

#### TRADING POST

Trading Post — A large trading post will be set up and operated on a 24-hour per day basis. It will feature most all the Arrowman's needs while attending the conference.

#### WOOD CARVING

Wood Carving — Ed Choby has been invited with his craved neckerchief slides and carving blocks.

#### RELIGIOUS SERVICES

Religious Services — Services will be arranged for all faiths.

#### SWAPPING

A swapping area will be provided and only open when activities are not scheduled.

#### PATCH

A patch and neckerchief has been designed and will be given to every Arrowman attending the conference.

#### AWARDS

Awards — Four awards may be won by each Lodge. They are as follows:
