We have designed and manufactured the fifteen flap shaped emblems shown on this page for use as space fillers in OA number collections. None of these lodges ever issued an emblem before they merged, but each lodge was assigned a unique number by National. Thus, these lodges represent the blank spaces in a numbers set. In addition to the fifteen emblems shown here, seven other emblems have been manufactured to represent those lodges that never issued an emblem but have had their numbers re-assigned by National since 1972. Each emblem has been screen-printed on felt and each features a different Indian design. The words "NO PATCH ISSUED" appear on each emblem.

We will give you a complete set of twenty-two space fillers if you contribute \$12.00 to Mountaineer Area Council. All money contributed is tax-deductible and will go to camp development. We have paid all manufacturing and design costs and have "purchased" an equivalent number of sets for our use in exchange for this at \$12.00 per set.
